## 2016 Summer League – Shoot-offs & Awards 2/15/16

### SHOOT-OFFS

Shoot-offs for all teams and individual venues will take place starting on **August 16<sup>th</sup>** and end on **August 28<sup>th</sup>**. Team captains must sign up in advance for the date and time of their shoot-off.

All teams and individual league shooters will be slotted into divisions after the last day of make-up week shooting. All teams and Individual League shooters who complete the regular season are eligible to be in the shoot-offs.

In order to be eligible to participate in shoot-offs, teams must have completed the entire league season. Eligibility for teams and shooters is determined as follows:

Teams in leagues that have an eighteen (18) week season must shoot all eighteen (18) weeks to be eligible for the shoot-offs. Team members must shoot a minimum of sixteen (16) of the eighteen (18) weeks to be eligible for the shoot-offs.

Teams in leagues that have a sixteen (16) week season must shoot all sixteen (16) weeks to be eligible for the shoot-offs. Team members must shoot a minimum of fourteen (14) of the sixteen (16) weeks to be eligible for the shoot-offs.

Teams and individuals in team and individual leagues that have a ten (10) week season must shoot all ten (10) weeks to be eligible for the shoot-offs.

In the event of a tie within a division after the regular season, and again after shoot-offs, an additional fifty-(50) target shoot-off will determine the winner. In the event of a tie after the fifty-(50) target shoot-off an additional twenty-five (25) targets will be shot until a winner is determined. All shoot-offs will take place simultaneously, when possible, using opposite fields for Trap and Skeet.

### BANQUET & AWARDS

The cost of the banquet will be \$5/person.

The board of directors determines what type of awards and cash value will be awarded to the winning teams and individuals. Awards will be in the form of SSPGC gift cards or target cards.

For all leagues, sixty (60) % of the league sponsorship monies will go toward awards. Forty (40) % of the sponsorship monies will go towards the raffle.

Divisions having at least five (5) teams in that division will receive a 1<sup>st</sup>- & 2<sup>nd</sup>-place award. Divisions having four (4) teams or less will only receive a 1<sup>st</sup>-place award. Individual and Mixed Pair Leagues will only receive 1<sup>st</sup>-place awards.

## **PAYOUTS – SPORTING CLAYS**

Of the 60% of sponsorship money allocated to awards:

### Regular Season Payouts

1<sup>st</sup> place teams in each Division after regular season will receive 10%

2<sup>nd</sup> place teams in each Division after regular season will receive 5%

High Guns in each League after the regular season will receive 5%

### Shoot-off Payouts

1<sup>st</sup> place teams in each Division after shoot-offs will receive 50%

2<sup>nd</sup> place teams in each Division after shoot-offs will receive 25%

High Guns in each League after shoot-offs will receive 5%

## **PAYOUTS – ALL OTHER LEAGUES**

Of the 60% of sponsorship money allocated to awards:

### Regular Season Payouts

1<sup>st</sup> place teams in each Division after the regular season will receive 20%

2<sup>nd</sup> place teams in each Division after the regular season will receive 10%

High Guns in each League after the regular season will receive 5%

### Shoot-off Payouts

1<sup>st</sup> place teams in each Division in shoot-offs will receive 40%

2<sup>nd</sup> place teams in each Division in shoot-offs will receive 20%

High Guns in each League in shoot-offs will receive 5%

## **RAFFLE DRAWINGS**

### Eligibility

Shooters in an 18-week league must shoot a minimum of sixteen (16) weeks of the eighteen (18) weeks to be eligible for the general raffle.

Shooters in a 16-week league must shoot a minimum of fourteen (14) weeks of the sixteen (16) weeks to be eligible for the general raffle.

Shooters in a 10-week league must shoot all ten (10) weeks to be eligible for the general raffle.

Shooters must have completed their entire league (shooting all of the required league rounds) to be eligible for the gun raffle.

Eligible shooters participating in more than one (1) league will have their name placed in the gun raffle for each venue in which they have participated.
