Program Description

THE PROGRAM

The program will be called the South St. Paul Rod & Gun Club Scholarship Program.

The sponsor will be South St. Paul Rod & Gun Club.

ELIGIBILITIES

Applicants must be:

- current or past employees of South St. Paul Rod & Gun Club, **OR**
- children or grandchildren of current members of South St. Paul Rod & Gun Club, **OR**
- high schools seniors from one of the following designated high schools:
 - Cretin-Derham Hall
 - Henry Senior High
 - Math & Sciences Academy
 - St. Croix Lutheran
 - St. Thomas Academy
 - East Ridge High School
 - Simley Senior High
 - South St. Paul Secondary
 - Woodbury Senior High

OR

- high school seniors attending any high school in the Twin Cities metro area.

Applicants must be high school seniors who plan to enroll in a full-time undergraduate course of study at an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school no later than Fall 2017.

AWARDS

The program will utilize standard Scholarship America recipient selection procedures including the consideration of past academic performance and future potential, leadership and participation in school and community activities, work experience, statement of career and educational aspirations and goals, unusual personal or family circumstances, and an outside appraisal.

- The authorized distribution for new awards will be \$6,000.
- Three (3) awards of \$2,000 each will be granted will be granted as follows:
 - Two awards will be granted to a current or past employee and/or child or grandchild of a current member, two of these awards will be for \$2,000
 - One award will be granted to a student attending one of the designated high schools, and
 - Or one award will be granted to a student attending any high school in the Twin Cities metro area.

If there are no qualified candidates who meet one or more of the above criteria, that award may be granted to the next most highly qualified candidate from among the pool of applicants.

- Financial need will not be considered.
- Awards are not renewable.
- Awards are for undergraduate study only.
