2017 Winter League Rules

11/18/16

All leagues are twelve (12) weeks in length. Leagues start **November 26, 2016** and run through **February 25, 2017**; Fourteen (14) weeks are allowed to complete twelve (12) rounds. League participants may shoot ahead or in arrears without limit, as long as all league rounds are completed within these dates. League shootoffs will occur **March 1–5, 2017**. Rounds shot during the annual Holiday Shoot may be counted as both league rounds and Holiday Shoot rounds **ONLY IF** shooters declare their intent prior to shooting the round. The Fall and Winter League Banquet is scheduled for **March 8, 2017**.

All leagues will be non-handicap leagues; all teams and individuals will shoot scratch. No blind scores are allowed.

Divisions will be determined by the Club at the end of the leagues. Each division must have at least five (5) teams in that division to receive a 1st and 2nd place award. Divisions having four (4) teams or less will only receive a 1st place award.

All team and individual league shooters will participate in shoot-offs within their divisions at the end of their leagues, however:

- For teams to be eligible to participate in shoot-offs, teams must complete the entire 12-week league season.
- League participants must shoot a minimum of ten (10) rounds of their 12-week league to be eligible to participate in shoot-offs.

In the event of a tie for awards within a division after shoot-offs, an additional fifty (50)-target shoot-off will determine the division winner. In the event of a tie after the fifty (50)-target shoot-off, an additional twenty-five (25) targets will be shot until a winner is determined.

To be eligible for a gun drawing at the league banquet, shooters must have shot all twelve (12) of their league rounds. To be eligible for the general drawing at the league banquet, shooters must have shot at least ten (10) of their league rounds.

LEAGUE-SPECIFIC RULES

Team Trap – there will be both 18 yard and 22 yard leagues. Teams may have up to ten (10) team members. The five (5) highest scores per team will count for each week.

Team Sporting Clays – teams may have up to ten (10) team members. The five (5) highest scores per team will count for each week.

Individual 28-ga. Sporting Clays – no special rules required.

Team 5-Stand – teams may have up to ten (10) team members. The five (5) highest scores per team will count for each week.
