### League Shoot-offs & Awards

#### SHOOT-OFFS

**All teams and Individual League shooters who “complete” the regular season as follows are eligible to be in the shoot-offs:**

Team members in an 18-round league must shoot a minimum of 16 of the 18 rounds.

Team members in a 16-round league must shoot a minimum of 14 of the 16 rounds.

Team members in a 15-round league must shoot all 15 rounds to be eligible for the shoot-offs.

Team members in a 12-round league must shoot a minimum of 10 of the twelve 12 rounds.

Teams and individuals in team and individual leagues in a 10-round season must shoot all 10 rounds.

All teams and individual league shooters will be slotted into divisions by scoring averages after the last day of the season (or the make-up week, if any) for shoot-offs. For a team to be in the shoot-offs, at least five (5) team members must complete the minimum number of rounds as listed above. **(Note: Even if your team does not participate in the shoot-offs, if you have “completed” the regular season as above, you are in the shoot-offs for individual high-gun.)**

Shoot-off winners will be determined by total scores shot in the shoot-offs. Shoot-off format:

- 50-target shoot-offs will occur for trap, skeet, 5-stand, sporting clays, and FITASC.
  - For trap and skeet shoot-off rounds must be shot on two different fields.
  - Both 16-yard trap shoot-off rounds will be shot from the 16-yard line.
  - Back-em-up shoot-off rounds will both be shot from the yardage closest to each individual shooter’s average, rounded up to the next highest yardage line.
- 100-target shoot-offs will occur for Tri-combo: one round each of skeet, 5-stand and sporting clays.

In the event of a tie within a division after the shoot-offs, an additional 25-target shoot-off will occur until a winner is determined:

- 16-yard trap shoot-off rounds will be shot from the 16-yard line.
- Back-em-up shoot-off rounds will be shot from the yardage closest to each individual shooter’s average, rounded up to the next highest yardage line.
- Sporting clays and Tri-combo shoot-off rounds will consist of 25 5-stand targets

**All Shoot-off rounds must be paid for, regardless of how many rounds were shot during the regular season.**

## **BANQUET & AWARDS**

The cost of the banquet will be \$5/person.

The Board of Directors determines what type of awards and cash value will be awarded to the winning teams and individuals. Awards will be in the form of SSPGC target cards only. **All payout awards must be collected within 60 days of the league banquet, or they will be forfeited; no exceptions.**

For all leagues, sixty (60) % of the league sponsorship monies will go toward awards. Forty (40) % of the sponsorship monies will go towards the raffle.

Divisions having at least five (5) teams in that division will receive a 1<sup>st</sup>- & 2<sup>nd</sup>-place award. Divisions having four (4) teams or less will only receive a 1<sup>st</sup>-place award. Individual and Mixed Pair Leagues will only receive 1<sup>st</sup>-place awards.

## **PAYOUTS – SPORTING CLAYS**

Of the 60% of sponsorship money allocated to awards:

### Regular Season Payouts

1<sup>st</sup> place teams in each Division after regular season will receive 10%

2<sup>nd</sup> place teams in each Division after regular season will receive 5%

High Guns in each League after the regular season will receive 5%

### Shoot-off Payouts

1<sup>st</sup> place teams in each Division after shoot-offs will receive 50%

2<sup>nd</sup> place teams in each Division after shoot-offs will receive 25%

High Guns in each League after shoot-offs will receive 5%

## **PAYOUTS – ALL OTHER LEAGUES**

Of the 60% of sponsorship money allocated to awards:

### Regular Season Payouts

1<sup>st</sup> place teams in each Division after the regular season will receive 20%

2<sup>nd</sup> place teams in each Division after the regular season will receive 10%

High Guns in each League after the regular season will receive 5%

### Shoot-off Payouts

1<sup>st</sup> place teams in each Division in shoot-offs will receive 40%

2<sup>nd</sup> place teams in each Division in shoot-offs will receive 20%

High Guns in each League in shoot-offs will receive 5%

## RAFFLE DRAWINGS

### Eligibility

To be eligible for the general raffle, shooters must have shot the same minimum number of rounds they had to shoot to be in the shoot-offs.

Shooters must have completed their entire league (shooting all the prescribed league rounds) to be eligible for the gun raffle.

Eligible shooters participating in more than one (1) league will have their name placed in the gun raffle for each venue in which they have participated and shot in all the prescribed rounds.
